My school physician reports that Harry Raven, an Arapahoe from Cheyenne & Arapahoe Agency, Ind. Terr., is under such indications of lung trouble as to make it advisable that he be sent home, and that Henry Outa, an Apache from the Kiowa, Comanche & Apache Agency, Ind. Terr., has been in the Hospital a long time under treatment for a disease brought on by his own imprudence, and had better be returned also. I request your authority to send them, and the transportation or authority to arrange it covering from Carlisle to Darlington, Ind. Terr. for Harry Raven,
