Sir:

Referring to my letter of Mch. 23rd ult. asking for return transportation for escort for party of Oneida children from De Pere, Wis. I have respectfully to inform you that as the transportation was not furnished by the Office, and Mr. Powlas had already waited four days, I purchased a ticket and sent him home, ^{Tuesday, March 27.} Yesterday I was informed by the R.R. Agent in Carlisle, that he was instructed to furnish a ticket Carlisle to De Pere for the escort.

I respectfully request that my action in purchasing a ticket for Mr. Powlas be approved, and that the ticket ordered

In this connection I would respectfully suggest that there ought to be some more logical means of arranging transportation than those at present in force, so that delays and apprehensions therefrom might be avoided, and the accounts and costs of the same compassed under one head.
