Sir:

In addition to the surplus in my hands for which I asked authority by letter dated the 21st inst., if my information is correct, we shall have nearly \$400.⁰⁰ of our Carlisle Appropriation in the Treasury not to my credit left over after paying beef, flour and other bills for current quarter. I therefore respectfully suggest that the young Crows at Ft. Snelling, ordered here by the President, might as well come on that fund and thus save its reversion to the Treasury.
