Sir:

Under the condemnation of the Board of Survey and your approval the old Military Hospital is to be torn down. This deprives my engineer and laundress of a dwelling. I propose to use the old material and erect a house for them.

In addition to this the teamsters' quarters have become untenable from rot and leakage and I shall be compelled to overhaul his house, new roof it, re-floor it and weather-board and plaster.

In addition to these two, the kitchen of the Disciplinarian's house, which was formerly the trader's store for many years, needs to be reorganized, with a new roof, weather-boarding and plastering.

We can do all the work ourselves, but to make the three buildings suitable for use we need :
