The Commis. of Ind. Affairs,

Sir:-

I am in receipt on the 6th inst of a telegram from Purcell D. T. signed by - Joshua H. Givon stating that he was waiting transportation for himself and party of Indians to Carlisle - The telegram mentioned no number of tickets, and my telegram to him to specify number required has not been replied to. I am - therefore in ignorance of the exact situation but understand it, that "Givon" is now at Purcell with an indefinite number of Indians waiting transportation.

Full instruction had been given in this matter with the request that "Givon" be guided by the Agent and notify me as soon as the number in the party could be ascertained.
