Sir—

I herewith return letter of Richard G. Robe, a pupil of this School from Rosebud Agency, Dak., and have respectfully to inform you, that he arrived here Nov. 14. 1883, for a five years term.

There is a letter from your Office, dated Jan. 16. '84, directing that, where the expiration of time for which pupils came, occurs during the school year, the pupil shall remain until the close of such school year.

I do not think that Richard is especially anxious to go home. An encouraging reply to make the best of the school, not only for the current year, but for several years more, if he can secure the opportunity,
