In reply to yours of the 19th inst. Marked
"Education - 868 - 1889", inclosing letter from
A. G. Miller in regard to admitting an Indian
boy to this School, I have respectfully to
inform you that when the lad was here
with his parents, I had my School Physician
examine him, and found he was rachitic
and not a strong appearing boy. He has
a manly face and bearing, and under the
implied authority of your letter I notify
Mr. Miller that we will accept him. His
parents are Onidas, but have been on the
road for many years.
