Sir:

My School Physician recommends that Elliott, a Kiowa who came to this School from Kiowa and Comanche Agency last Fall, should be returned on account of ill health; also that W^m Short nose and Robert Left Hand, from Cheyenne and Arap^o Agency, who have been here since Sept. 1886, be returned for the same reason.

I concur in his recommendation and respectfully request your authority and to be supplied with the necessary transportation. Elliott will need a ticket from Gettysburg Junction to Purcell, Ind. Ferry. William and Robert two tickets to Oklahoma Ind. Ferry. They can take care of themselves.
