The Commr. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:

The accommodations for our teachers' mess are not sufficient, and it becomes necessary to make additions to meet this want. I propose an addition, 20 x 20 ft., ^{brick,} two stories, to the kitchen of the present building; the upper room to be used by the cook, the lower for a kitchen. The present dining room to be enlarged by taking out partition between it and present kitchen. I also wish to build a porch to the addition, and dig a cellar.

We can do all the work connected with this improvement except masons' and plasterers', for which I shall have to hire skilled labor. I respectfully request your authority to expend the sum
