Replying to yours of the 19th desiring me to recommend a suitable person for appointment as Physician at this School I have to respectfully inform you that on inquiry I have been unable to fully satisfy myself that either of the nine physicians who have applied to me were suited for the place, and have preferred to wait until I could perhaps find a suitable man. We are now quite a little community and the sanitary interests are most important. The person appointed must be able to help the School in other ways than as a mere physician.

I will come down to Washington in a few days to consult with you about this and other School matters.
