Sir:

It becomes necessary to purchase a new range for the teachers' and employes' mess. I have looked the grounds over and find that the range made by Bramhall, Deane & Co. N. Y., shown on page 9 of their catalogue, suits best. I have corresponded with them and they will furnish the range and fixtures for \$183.<sup>50</sup> - 40% off f. o. b. in New York, making \$110.<sup>00</sup>. A galvanized boiler holding sixty gallons will cost \$19. net. These things are necessary and the price reasonable and I respectfully request your authority to make the purchase amounting to \$129.<sup>00</sup>
