Dear Sir;

In compliance with instructions from Hon. Commr. of Indian Affairs, I write you in reference to children from Flandreau., and have to respectfully advise you we desire children above 12 and under 18 years of age. They should be proper subjects both mentally and physically, and that fact should be attested by medical examination and evidence of it come to us on forms herewith. When out myself after children I have always pursued the Army methods of examination as far as possible, having a lady assist the Doctor in examining the girls. We keep a careful record of our students and the information required on this blank is needed for our records. It is also important we have equal numbers of boys and girls. As our room is at present arranged this is the more important and we could not well accept an excess of boys.

On notice from you of number of tickets required I will have the necessary transportation from such point as you indicate to Carlisle placed to your order. If the youth are of such intelligence as I suppose the Flandreau youth to be, they can come to Carlisle without escort, but if
