Sir:

In compliance with your request of 18th instant you are hereby authorized to appoint two disinterested and properly qualified persons a Board of Survey to examine, report the present actual conditions and to recommend what in their opinion would be the proper means to dispose of the property named in the list you submit and which you say is no longer serviceable. You will instruct the Board to divide the property into the following classes.

- 1st Such as can be economically repaired and put to further use
- 2nd Such as can be used in making repairs
- 3rd Such as would probably sell for some reasonable price if offered at public sale and
- 4th Such as is utterly worthless for any purpose and may be condemned to destruction.

Submit the findings of the Board to this Office for its consideration and await a reply before acting upon them.



December 3rd. inst., or as soon thereafter as practicable, to examine into and report upon the condition and recommend the disposition to be made of certain unserviceable property of the United States pertaining to the Indian Department, named in Schedule submitted to the Indian Office November 18th. 1889, and for which Capt. R.H. Pratt, 10th. Cavy., Supt. is responsible.
