To the Commissioner of Indian Affairs:

Sir: I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, &c., required for the service at the agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$*460.⁷⁰*, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same⁽¹⁾ *in open Market*

I also ask authority to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals in the case, in the ⁽²⁾

and to make contract with the lowest responsible bidder, or bidders, for the delivery of the articles estimated for.
