To the Honorable,  
The Com'r of Indian Affairs,  
Washington, D. C.,

Sir:

Replying to your letter of the 20, inst. marked Education, 8266-1890, I have the honor to state that the three children in question, John Hill, age 15, Sophia, age 19 and Suffie, age 13, were received at this school from Martinsburg, Pa. June 22, 1888, where they were entered March 1885.

The two younger are in country homes, Sophia is going to school here, is in the Fourth Grade and has excellent health.

In view of the ages of these children, it would not seem wise to return them to any less favorable conditions than they now have unless the very strongest reasons exist for so doing. They appear on the record as having no mother living, but had a good step-mother. An older brother, now at Hampton, has expressed himself as desirous that they remain at school while they can. I return herewith, enclosure.
