Sir:-

I have the honor to forward herewith account of T. W. Potter, and employe of this school, for expenses incurred in attending the funeral of Ira Goss, late one of our pupils, who died in Bucks Co. Penna., while out on farm. The account also includes expenses of medical attendance and funeral.

Our School Physician visited the boy with the intention to bring him to Carlisle; but his condition was such as to render his removal impossible. The disease ran rapidly to the fatal termination, and the expenses incurred were unavoidable.

I also inclose account of Kate Irvine, an employe, for expenses incurred in visiting

Lucy Teisnah, a pupil out in a family in York Co. Pa. and bringing her to Carlisle. This account includes amount charged by medical attendant, whose services were necessary until the girl could be removed. She was brought home as soon as she was able to travel
