I have been here only two
months, and 12 days.

I received letters from My
Mother stating that Father

Grand-mother, Uncle Little
Hawk, and brother canite are
dead and wanted me at
home.

I write this to you to see if
I could go home to Pine Ridge
Agency S. Dakota this summer
or not.

write and let me know soon
so I can tell Mother whether
I stay or go.
