Sir:

Referring to your letter of the 29, inst., marked "Education, 15485, 16060-'90, giving instructions to return Edward Star to Pine Ridge Agency, I respectfully suggest that there be no direct information given Edward Star of the decision of the Office, as coming from the Office in response to his application, but that the action be taken as coming in the usual course of returning students for expiration of time or other reasons, at the end of the school session, July 1st.

I recommend this in order to avoid future trouble to the Office and to the school, by needless application of the pupils, as every case is carefully considered in making up the home lists at the right time.
