To the Commissioner of Indian Affairs:

Sir: I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, &c., required for the service at the agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$499.⁴³00, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same⁽¹⁾ in open market.
