Commr. of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:-

Replying to your letter of January 24th, marked "Finance, 1633, 1 Inclos." (no enclosure received) in reference to voucher in favor of Rev. J. J. Emmegahbou and Rev. Chas. Wright for travelling expenses from Washington to Carlisle and thence to White Earth Agency, Minn., I have to respectfully advise you that I furnished a return ticket to Rev. Emmegahbou from Carlisle to White Earth. The incidental expenses were to come, as I now remember, in the shape of a special voucher, supported by sub-vouchers from him after he reached the agency, which is the course I usually pursue. Mr. Wright was not connected with the incoming party in any way, nor did I feel warranted in paying his expenses. He came to Carlisle some time after Rev. Emmegahbou arrived. When they returned from Washington on their way west they told me of their very kind reception by the Honorable Secretary and the Acting Commissioner, Mr. Belt, and that the Secretary had promised to cover their expenses not covered by me. As I understood it, they anticipated their expenses from Carlisle to


