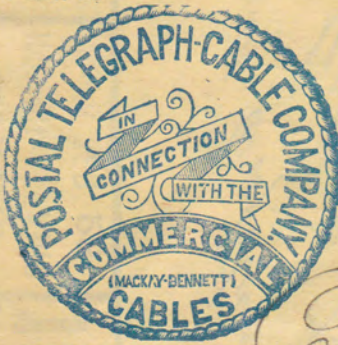

5 your telegram that Senate Committee

 90 adopted and the Catholic influences continue
 95 to dominate I have no regrets in retiring from
 100 the Service
