During the Chason Appropriation last Fall I was for six weeks without a Matron in charge of the girls, and before the Bill became law I had selected Miss Dittus for the position. According to instructions I paid her at the old rate - \$720.00 per year - but placed her name on the Regular Roll, intending to nominate her as soon as the law enabled me to do so. It seems that this was irregular and that the difficulty cannot be overcome, except by submitting her name on the Irregular Report and asking approval. This I do herewith.
