Sir:

As explained to you in my letter of 5th inst., I was unable to hold my assistant music teacher without advancing her salary to \$540. This places the relative position of the music teacher and the assistant music teacher awkwardly. As the music teacher had asked for no advance I did not think it necessary to grant one. Since hearing of the proposed advance in the salary of the assistant she has notified me of her unwillingness to serve at a salary of \$500. She is not only indefatigable in her efforts but very competent, and having been with us a long time a proper recognition of her services warrants an advance in her salary to \$600 per annum; and I respectfully request that the salary for music teacher be increased to \$600 and that of the assistant to \$540, as before requested.
