## ESTIMATE OF INDIAN SUPPLIES, &amp;c.,

Required for the Service of the

*Indian Training School Agency Carlisle Barracks, Pa.*During the *First* quarter, 188*7*.

To the Commissioner of Indian Affairs:

Sir: I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, &c., required for the service at the agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$*496.<sup>25</sup>*, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same <sup>(1)</sup> *in open market*

I also ask authority to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals in the case, in the <sup>(2)</sup>

and to make contract with the lowest responsible bidder, or bidders, for the delivery of the articles estimated for.

I have on hand <sup>(3)</sup> \$ *No funds* available to the proposed purchase, from appropriation
