My Grandson went to Carlisle, Penn., to school last year and he is not a very healthy boy, but he went off to school without my permission and he has been writing to me and complaining that he is sick all the time and I have to send him medicine twice this summer and if you will write to Capt Pratt about it and if he is not healthy I want him to come home he used to be sick with Urinary disease and I am afraid
