Sir:

During the progress of the erection of the barn on the Parker Farm (Mr. Glauser, contractor) just after the arch over the driveway was completed and covered with earth, there came continuous rains. Neither the walls nor the arch being yet dry and settled, and the wall not having the advantage of the weight of the building upon it, the weight of earth and arch broke down the arch and crowded the wall on the barn side out. The chutes from the barn floor into the cellar weakened the wall and the arch supporting the roadway entering the barn, and it seemed best, in restoring, to leave them out and also strengthen the wall on the barn side of the archway and give more curve to the arch. I instructed the contractor to go ahead and restore the arch and rebuild the wall, with these modifications, and we would share the cost. He agreed to that and has kept a careful account, separate from his other, which I accept, the total of which, in labor and

material, amounts to \$359.33. I respectfully request your  
authority to pay the contractor the one half of this cost,  
amounting to \$179.66, as per my agreement with him.
