Dear Sir

G. Morgan.

I am going to write to you to-day. Now to-day I am thinking myself to sit in my room. I have been here at Carlisle School for seven years. But now I haven't got any cents in the bank. Last winter Capt he asked me the whole school if we would help him pay for the Gymnasium for \$5000. So I put \$30.00 for Gymnasium but now he dont pay me for six months since I have been Carlisle I never trouble with the teacher and I never

killed any body either I don't  
seen why he punish me for  
nothing. Last spring he sent  
me out to the Bucks County  
to work. And I stay there nearly  
two months, and the man I work  
for him very good man but he  
give me \$13. a months work hard  
So I don't satisfied with that  
\$13. and <sup>capt</sup> he think that I run away  
from that place, but I did not  
run away. He know that I was  
coming back to school, because  
I write to him befor. I said that  
I want come back, so he sent  
me the ticket to come back  
on it, and after I came back  
he put me work the outside for  
the whole summer with out pay  
and other day I asked about it  
pay. I said why I don't get no pay  
Capt? he say well you are the

one punish and I said well  
Capt how you expect to pay  
me for Gymnasium. I put 3000  
if you don't pay me? and he  
say he don't <sup>care</sup> about it to pay  
Gymnasium. and I said to  
him how long you don't  
give me no pay and he say  
I don't know mayb I keep you  
a years. and I am very sorry  
what the Capt had say to me  
these words and I am thinking  
about it to go out West this time.  
Because I get punish for nothing  
well Mr Morgan, you are  
in charge very Indian so  
I would like to ask you please  
can you let me go home  
this winter? And if you don't  
let me go home why I like  
to go visit to see my people I  
have n't see for nearly eight
