The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Replying to Office letters marked "Education 36855-1891 Auth: 27509 and 36855-91 39822-91, dated Nov. 5 + 24, 1891, I have respectfully to state that under Authy. " 27509 for construction of Boiler House, I have expended \$675.<sup>53</sup> for labor, the balance of the \$1500. being required for material.

In reference to payment of 40 cents per day to Nellie Cary, I have to say that we have 230 girls to attend to in Quarters, which requires more labor than

the Matron and Asst. Matron can perform.  
 Nellie has been at the school from its  
 beginning, is fully acquainted with the  
 duties of the position, and competent  
 I carry her on the roll as a pupil,  
 furnishing her boarding, but she purchases  
 her own clothing. I think the pay reasonable  
 and as low as it should be under the  
 circumstances.
