Festus has improved, and although he has been without the usual apprentice pay for nearly six months he deserves just what he is receiving, and the fact that it hurts is only a satisfactory proof of the wholesomeness of the punishment. He will come off the no pay list on Dec. 31. In regard to his going home, his career here has been such as to lead us to be willing to get rid of the bother, but, for his own good and its influence on the other Apaches, I think the home going had better be left in my hands.
