Dear Captain:--

After a careful investigation, I would respectfully state, in compliance with your request, that the present status of the returned Carlisle students, as contained in the list you send me, is as stated opposite the name of each.

In this connection, I would state that my judgment favors taking the most charitable view in regard to the cases of those reported as bad, indifferent, and doubtful. The question of a few good people of any race being able to leaven the whole lump, is certainly one depending largely upon the character of those that do the leavening, and the time we allow for the leaven to work. Necessarily, a portion of the leaven must fail to work satisfactorily, its life and force being overcome by the mass in which it is placed. The tremendous weight of centuries of barbaric influences that is at present bearing down upon this people, entails fearful labor in giving birth to a new civilization. Those who look upon this question from an impartial standpoint, should feel not only encouraged, but indeed would be justified in feeling
