Sir:-

Since the return of Charles Damon from the Carlisle Indian Training School, to his home here, he has repeatedly visited this school and during his visits he has talked to the Navajo boys, about their going to the Carlisle school, and six or seven have signified a willingness to go. As yet I have said nothing to their parents, I therefore--request that I be authorized (provided the consent of the parents be obtained), to take six or more Navajo boys to said school.
