Sir:

Capt. Brown, Acting Indian Agent at Pine Ridge, requests me to have Jennie Dubray take the Civil Service examination with the view to a position of full teacher in the Indian service, so as to enable her and her husband, that is to be, - Clarence Three Stars - to take charge of one of his day schools. I have some doubt as to Jennie's ability to pass the examination and yet she is a great deal better qualified for teacher, and has a better education, than a very considerable number of teachers in Indian schools that I have known. It will certainly do her no harm to appear before the Board.

As my previous letters to the Board on the subject of her examination as assistant teacher were not noticed by the Board, and I got my reply through the Indian Office, I address you and request that I may be placed in the way of
