I return herewith the examination papers in the cases of Loren E. Wolfe, Brighton, Ills., #186; Nelson M. Hayner, Schaghticoke, N. Y., #46; and J. Alfred Maule, Topton, Pa., #45; and respectfully advise you that neither of these applicants at all commends himself to me, by intelligence and quality, as suitable to fill the place of teacher for No. 11, and to further state that I should deplore being compelled to use either of them as teacher in any of the lower departments at this school, as it would be a long stride towards degrading the standard of our teaching force. I request that the Honorable Commissioner himself run over these papers and see how evidently incompetent the applicants are, and that he direct that the next step in this system be taken, ^{at once} to provide us a competent teacher.
