

Sir:

Replying to your letter of November 7th marked "Education, 39256" enclosing letter of Perry H. Laravie I have respectfully to advise you that Laravie came here at his own option and cost on April 22th 1888, that he is not at all promising as a student and for several years I have had him in the country under our outing system where he has practicably supported himself and had the benefit of winter schooling. He is entirely capable of making his own way and has a saving of \$101.28, he is about twenty-four years of age and as he came here voluntarily and at his own expense I see no reason why he should not depart in the same way. We have done what we could for him and he is capable of independence and self-support, away from the reservation.
