
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

Referring to paragraph 155 Rules for Indian Schools Course of Study etc., I respectfully request decision as to liberty to be given teachers under that paragraph. For instance, we give the ten days recess at Christmas, will it be within the intention of the rules to allow teachers to be absent during that time provided duties are carried on here and that absence not count ~~in~~ in their annual allowance. My understanding has been that only the two holidays, Christmas and New Years, and the other regular holidays and the thirty days leave every year were allowed without loss of pay unless under an authorized sick leave.
