The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Our Printing Office has heretofore been provided with about all its equipment from our charity fund. There is no money in it, and my charity fund is continually drained to meet running expenses.

The two "Universal" presses on which we have printed the "Indian Helper," which has a circulation of eight to ten thousand a week, were second-hand when we bought them nine or ten years ago. One of them has given completely out and the other is barely working. We need a new press, and I now think our appropriation should stand the expense of the Printing Office instead of my charity fund, and respectfully request authority to purchase a No. 3 "Eclipse" Press, 12 x 17 1/2 inches inside, with fountain, and to pay the sum of \$350.00 for the same.
