To The COMMISSIONER OF INDIAN AFFAIRS.

SIR:

I have the honor to transmit an estimate of supplies, etc., required for the service at the agency under my charge, as above, amounting to \$ 455.51, and respectfully ask for the necessary authority to purchase the same in open market

I also ask authority to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals in the case, in the <sup>2</sup>

and to make contract with the lowest responsible bidder, or bidders, for the delivery of the articles estimated for.

I have on hand <sup>3</sup>\$ available to the proposed purchase, from appropriation
