The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,



Sir:

Referring to your letter of January 26th, marked "Education, 1462-93," which says "The difference of 12 ¢ for Indian labor between your report and the amount approved is caused by a mis-calculation on part of your office for the item of labor for James P. Yellow, twelve and one-half days at 24 ¢ per day, which amounts to \$3.00 instead of \$3.12," I have to respectfully advise you that thirteen days is correct. By my records and by pay roll of irregular employes he had 1/2 day each on the 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, & 31, making a total of twenty-six (26) half days, or thirteen (13) full days, which at 24 ¢ per day amounts to \$3.12.

If my report varied from this it was an error of a clerical nature, and the facts as given herein should govern.
