The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Referring to that part of your letter of March 29th marked "Education, 9936-10551," in reference to Miss Fisher, I have to respectfully advise you that she left us on the 15th and in paying her to April 8th I covered all the leave of absence time that she had due her on account of service here. She desired a full month's absence and understood that she would forfeit the pay between the 8th and the 15th of April.

I endeavor always to have these matters thoroughly understood and to be entirely within the Regulations and arrange that no claims for other pay than I make shall come up, and do not remember of a single case where claims have been presented on account of Carlisle during the whole period of its history.
