

Replying to your letter of June 7th marked "Education 20208" enclosing letter from James J. Dolan in behalf of Chief Plato in reference to his son claimed to be in this school, I have to respectfully advise you that we have never had any Mescalero Apaches and there is no mention of any boy on our records whose father is named "Plato" and that none of our Apache boys from San Carlos or Indian Territory or Mt. Vernon here present at the school know anything of any such boy. The boy is probably at some other school.
