
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

In reply to yours of the 15th marked "Education, 21265" in reference to letter to you from Amos Hamilton, pupil in this school, which letter is herewith returned, I have respectfully to advise you that Amos is already notified that several previous payments amounting to \$600.00 or \$700.00 have been allowed him and that he will soon receive a check for the same from the Treasury Department. He had letters from home urging him to come home and draw this money and subsequent payments due soon for the benefit of his friends. His letter to you refers to these last payments. Amos desires that all money due him be paid him here. His health is not very good and I am considering the advisability of sending him home and would suggest that as he has an abundance of money in prospect that it would be just as well for the present at least to have payments hereafter due remain in Washington until he gets settled and that he be so advised.
