The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

This Commission is in receipt of your communication of June 17th, replying to the letter of the Commission of the 10th instant requesting information as to the reasons why no selections were made from certificates Nos. 244, 246, and 247, in which you state that Captain Pratt, superintendent of the Carlisle school, for which school these certifications were made, examined the same and objected to the appointment of any of the persons named in these certificates.

In reply, you are informed that the Commission cannot accept any objection to any person included in a certification unless that objection is made in accordance with the requirement of section 3 of General Rule IV. As no statement has been made to this Commission that the eligibles, or any of them, whose names were included in the certifications named were, because of physical incapacity or for other good cause particularly specified, not capable of properly performing the duties of the place to which they were certified, the Commission cannot sustain the general objection made by Captain Pratt. When specific objections shall be made in the manner required by this rule

the Commission will consider whether or not they can be sustained.
