

Sir:--

Replying to your letter of the 21st inst., marked Education, 26,306, enclosing letter from John Wilson, Caddo, who appeals to you for the return of his grand-children, Samuel Wilson and Minnie Finley, I have respectfully to advise you that Samuel is now out in the country and obligated until the middle of September, and it seems to me very much better for the boy that he should keep his agreement. When the students return from the country about the middle of September, it is my purpose to take all who are willing to pay \$10.00 for the trip, to Chicago, for one week at the World's Fair. This is a promise I made to the school last winter. It will be a great education for them, and it seems to me that it would be better to let Samuel and Minnie remain here until that time, go with us to the Fair, and from there go on home. Under the circumstances, I do not object to their return. Mr. Wilson will, I am sure, fall in with this arrangement, and be satisfied. His letter is herewith returned.
