Cattaraugus Reservation,
July 31st 1898

Honorable Commissioner
of Indian Affairs.
Washington. D. C.

Sir,

I desire to state ^{and} call your immediate
action in the following.

I have a daughter at the Carlisle, Pa. Indian
Industrial School whose name is Jennie Tall-
chief. who was induced to go at said school
without my consent ^{and} without my knowledge.
but being in favor in the promotion of education
among our people, I have remained silent.

After my daughter was gone about two weeks, I
received (herewith enclosed) printed agreement ^{asking} for
my signature. I refuse to sign the same.

Now therefore, I ask the Hon Commissioner
to cause that my daughter be sent home. as
she desires to come home. On the ground of
the above statement. ^{and} as I deem, that this
is a plain case of kidnap.

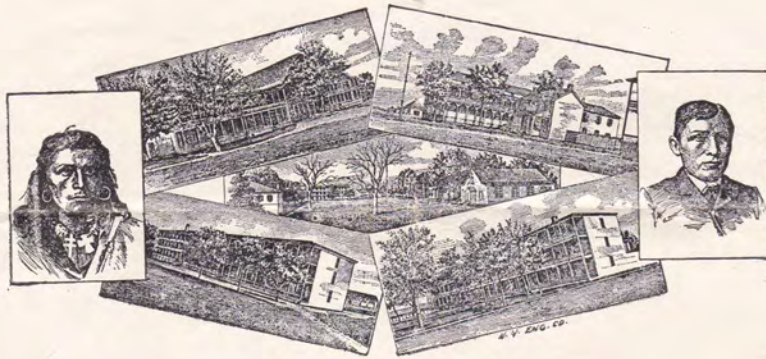
