*Replying to your letter of Nov. 11th. marked "E 41799, 93" in regard to my report of irregular employes for the month ending October 31st. '93, in which you state that you find employed an assistant laundress to fill a vacancy for 25 days at a compensation of \$1.00 per day, &c., I have to respectfully advise you that the regular assistant laundress, Miss Jamison, has been on the sick list for some months, and that the statement on my report against temporarily employed laundress should have been "in place of Miss Jamison, sick", instead of "to fill vacancy". A reference to my regular receipt roll will show that Miss Jamison was not paid for the time that her salary was used to pay for a temporary service.*
