Sir:-

Replying to your letter of January 3rd marked "Finance" 47316, covering \$300 now to the credit of Susie Farwell, a Crow Indian girl of this school, etc., I have to respectfully advise you that Susie is 18 years of age. She is large, strong and womanly and is exceptionally capable. She came to this school in 1890 from the Crow Agency and is without doubt the same person whose land and improvements were taken by the Rock Fork & Cook City Railroad Company. She can safely place her money on interest at 6% here, and if consistent with the regulations of the Department I would recommend that her request be granted.
