Before the close of last school year I gave our teachers to understand that we would increase the school room work to 3 or 3 1/2 hours in the forenoon and afternoon, and add one more study hour evening each week. At the beginning of this school year the increase was made to 3 hours forenoon and afternoon and Thursday evening was added as a study hour, making 4 study hour evenings each week. With this understanding Miss McAdam continued in our service. Miss McAdam is an excellent teacher, but has been ailing for a year or two. Last spring she had a month's sick leave.

The best interests of the pupils would be served by adding still another 1/2 hour to the
