Sir:

In compliance with instructions
contained in Communication Education 20629-1894
June 2^d 1894, I have the honor to report that I
sent for Mrs Sarah Hawk of Afloo I.T. and by in-
vestigation found his statement substantially
true, as in her letter dated May 26/94 to the Hon:
Com: of Indian Affairs, she is Paralytic, un-
able at times to move her lower limbs, and too
young to hire help. The day she came to see me
in response to my letter of June 6. 1894, she
was unable to get out of the wagon, and looked
in very feeble health, and needs the care and
protection of some one, and not being able

financially to give help, I think it would be
just to allow her son Noak Hawk to go home
to his mother.
