

Sir:

It becomes necessary to make a change in our drainage which we now turn into the small stream which runs through our cow pasture. A cess pool which can be emptied upon the land periodically seems to offer the safest and best accomodation. I propose a cess pool 12X30 and 12 feet deep, below the shops with a dry wall. We shall also need 350 feet of 10, 6 and 5 inch terra cotta pipe. I respectfully request authority to expend \$270.00 for these purposes out of the appropriation for the current quarter as I will have the money. This authority should come immediately.
