The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Replying to your letter of the 10th instant marked "Education, 25570-94," enclosing a letter from the Agent at Blackfoot Agency, asking for the return home of Eddie Running Crane, a pupil of this school, I have the honor to state that Eddie Running Crane entered this school March 1890 and is therefor now in the last year of the term for which he came.

He is at present away from the school for the summer months to return in the fall and take up his studies, which should do him more good this session than at any time previously, by reason of his present ability as compared with what it was at first.

Under the circumstances it looks as though the father should in justice to his son's future allow him to finish his term at Carlisle; unless to do so would entail unusual hardship.

It would be a great pity to deprive the boy of his last and best year year of schooling for any but the most urgent cause.
